

Use our "College budgets templates" to manage a college student's budget for one academic year.

The template contains several tables and several summary charts. Let's look at tables first. The first block is a table for accounting for student income:

Income	Quarter 1	Quarter 2	Quarter 3	Summer
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- The first column of the "Income" table contains a list of possible sources of student income;
- In the columns that follow "Quarter 1", "Quarter 2", "Quarter 3", and "Summer" you need to record the total income for the corresponding periods of the academic year.
- At the bottom of the table is the summary line, in which the total income for each specified period is calculated;
- On the right is the summary column, which summarizes the value across the rows.

An example of a completed table:

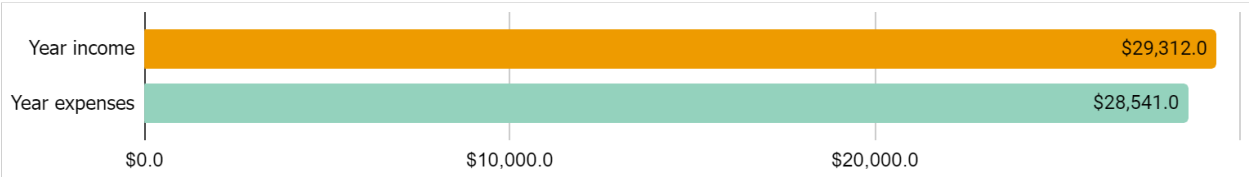
An example of a completed expense table:

On the top charts, you will be able to assess the level of use of your budget.



The first chart shows quarterly expenses and incomes. Incomes are displayed in orange to the left of the axis; expenses are displayed in green to the right of the axis. The total values are also signed; you can evaluate the resulting savings or cost overruns.



On the second diagram, you can see the financial results of the entire period in total.
